ESTIMATED TIME OF ARRIVAL (ETA) CODES

The ETA code is used by shippers to indicate the number of days a shipment will be in transit from the consignor to a Port of Embarkation (POE). Using the ETA code and the date shipped code, the POE is able to determine when the shipment will arrive.
