Master Lease Modification Process

- When requesting a modification for the DoD Master Lease Contract, COR must submit a Memorandum for Record (MFR) to KO outlining the modification requested and the reason for and impact of the modification.
- COR must also attach any supporting documentation necessary to justify and/or support the modification.

- Effective November 20, 2009
- ✦ Standardized chassis inspection process
- Improvement in chassis maintenance results in improved chassis fleet
- Minimize claim disputes

Training Way Ahead

- Container Management Curriculum has been approved by the Director of GCM and is ready for integration into the TRADOC school house curriculums of both the Officer Basic Course and the Warrant Officer Basic Course.
- Coordinating with Camp Shelby to integrate CM training into National Guard pre-deployment training program
- Working with SDDC Groups to develop generic container management processes which will be tailored for specific locations



DoD Biennial Container Inventory 2010

- Directed by USTRANSCOM in accordance with the Defense Transportation Regulation 4500.9-R, Part VI
- Programmed for 1 JAN 2010 – 30 JUN 2010, per user request and consensus at Container Workshop.
- Army Container Asset Management System (ACAMS) is the inventory system of record for the DoD inventory.
- No activity within the last 2 biennial inventories will be archived (soft delete) Services may request exceptions.
- The inventory consists of two parts
 - Ownership verification
 - Location (on-hand) verification
 - CSC inspection due date
 - Container Use Code



DoD Biennial Container Inventory 2010

- Identify Directive authority for container management
- Designate IPT to work alternative storage solutions (DAG4)
- Designate Container Manager for each COCOM
- Leasing Reduction Strategies The inventory consists of two parts
