JIPMS Background

Goal: Define functional capabilities desired in a joint system to track and manage intermodal assets worldwide – providing a single system / interface for inventory managers and operational forces on the ground.

- **Distribution Steering Group** – JIWG produced a Joint Intermodal Platform Management System (JIPMS) Abbreviated Capabilities Based Assessment Team report findings to the DSG
- **ACBAT established Jan 07 with members from:**
 - DSG, JIWG, COCOMs, Services, and Agencies
- **Site visits/system review conducted Feb 07 – May 07**
 - Four systems: ACAMS, IBS-CMM, AIMS, PAT

JIPMS Background cont'd

- **Business Case Analysis provided to DSG, Jun 07**
- **BCA recommended Courses of Action, Sep 07**
 - **Spiral 1** – Focus on data sharing, service oriented architecture or Net-centric concepts and system to system interface – completed
 - **Spiral 2** – Migrate to single data source, single sign-on and integration with other initiatives
 - JIPMS data sharing between IBS-CMM and ACAMS became operational in September 2008
 - The two systems continue to exist and have not evolved into a single database / capability
- **Although data sharing between IBS-CMM and ACAMS has been demonstrated in an operational environment, the true intent of the JIPMS initiative has not been realized.**
