JIPMS Phase Overview

- Per 2007 JIPMS Implementation Plan, Phase I was to include:
 - Data sharing
 - automatic transfer of data between the systems
 - systems continue to access their own databases
 - Develop Single Sign On (SSO)
 - System to System interfaces
 - System migrations
- Phase II was to include:
 - Single data source
 - Implement Single Sign On
 - Integration with other initiatives (e.g. COP D2)
 - User interfaces

JIPMS Proposed Way Ahead

- Global Container Management/Container Management Division recommends following Phase I implementation be completed:
 - Data sharing
 - automatic transfer of data between the systems; ensure all data elements required are being transferred (target NLT 30 Jun 2010)
 - systems continue to access their own databases
 - Develop Single Sign On (SSO)
- And the following for Phase II:
 - Implement Single Sign On (ETA as one possible COA)

JIPMS Proposed Way Ahead (2)

- Ultimately GCM foresees a JOINT system of record – or one designated specifically to support all Services
 - Would be managed via Joint control to meet all Service requirements
- Other Proposed Actions:
 - Comprehensive requirements review in FY11, funded by OSD
 - Independent system review and evaluation in FY11, funded by OSD
 - IBS-CMM be fully integrated into IBS
 - iSDDC be utilized as reporting capability for container management;
 - Leverage data feeds from ACAMS and IBS-CMM
 - Resident capability for detention estimator
- Pending results of review and evaluation, IBS-CMM continue to facilitate Ingate/Outgate of Containers, Carrier Notification events
- Worldwide implementation and use of IBS-CMM for contingencies where directed by COCOM / established as part of COCOM procedures
- Technology for accurate, automatic logging of ingate/outgate of containers
