AF Container Management

- AFI 24-203, Chapter 14 “Management of Modular, Intermodal Containers and 463L Assets”
- Updating responsibilities (starting with HQ USAF and AFGLSC)
 - AFGLSC (401 SCMS/GUMA) is AF ISO Container Manager
 - Adding instructions for CCOs to report new container purchases to AF Container Manager
- Creating more container managers within programs that use containers
- Adding CCO responsibility to use ACAMS and AIDPMO to manage containers

AF ISO Container Issues

1. Improve integration of ACAMS with organizations who use other forms of container management (MEDLOG, Munitions, etc.)
2. Convey the relevance of strong container management habits.
3. Encourage CCOs to complete inventories well ahead of deadlines.
