# Scope of MIL-HDBK-138

- The handbook applies to the selection of any commercially owned or military owned intermodal container meeting the standards of the ISO and certified under the provisions of the Int'l CSC. The handbook is specifically used by worldwide civilian and military personnel responsible for inspecting and selecting serviceable intermodal containers for shipment of DoD materiel.
- Opportunity - during the conversion process are there other potential container related requirements to include in MIL-STD-3037?

# Status

- Meeting between DAC (Agent) & ARDEC (Preparing Activity) to discuss content of new standard was conducted at ARDEC, 20 Jan 11.
- DAC prepared and submitted the preliminary draft to ARDEC, TBD.
- ARDEC to ensure compliance to MIL-STD-962 and prepare the first draft, 15 business days.
- ARDEC to initiate the informal coordination of first draft, 15 business days.

# Road Map

1. Develop and submit a justification/business case for the conversion/update to the Army Standardization Manager (ASM).
2. Revise justification/business case, if necessary, to receive approval from ASM.
3. Develop draft standard, collaborating with DoD, other Gov't, and non-Gov't stakeholders (multiple write-review-revise cycles, as needed). (STDZN Project # 8115-2010-003/MIL-STD-3037)
4. Conduct formal STDZN 30-day full-coordination review of MIL-STD-962 compliant semi-final draft with all stakeholders (via ASSIST and e-mail).
5. Review any comments received and address as appropriate.
6. Provide feedback on any “essential” comments (versus “suggested”) that were received from DoD.

# Road Map

7. Revise semi-final draft, if necessary.
8. Re-coordinate semi-final draft (10-day), if necessary.
9. Request and receive memo from LSA, Custodians, and all Review Activities indicating concurrence with final draft.
10. Submit final draft and concurrence memos to ASM, who who will obtain ASE approval for publication.
11. Submit final draft with ASE approval memo to DAPS for publication in ASSIST.
12. Address comments from DAPS, if applicable.
13. Revise final draft and resubmit to DAPS, if applicable.
