

# CM Definitions

- 1 Container management: The execution of all functions and responsibilities required to provide for the life cycle and operational management of DOD and Service-owned, leased or controlled ISO containers.
- 2 Container management encompasses all functions and responsibilities required to provide life cycle and operational management of all DOD/Service-owned, leased or controlled ISO containers from cradle to grave or from their entry into the Defense Transportation System (DTS) to their exit.
- 3 Container Management: Planning, organizing, directing, controlling, and executing of all functions and responsibilities required to provide for positive and effective use of DOD/Service-owned, leased or controlled ISO containers. Includes, but is not limited to, the functions and responsibilities of life cycle asset and operational management supporting the full spectrum of operations.

# CM Definitions

- 4 Container Management: The direction, control, and execution of all functions and responsibilities required to provide for positive and effective disposition of DOD/Service-owned, leased or controlled ISO containers. Includes, but is not limited to, the functions and responsibilities of life cycle and operational management; encompassing inventory control, inventory reporting, identification, cataloging, standardization, requirements determination, procurement, inspection, certification, quality control, distribution, disposal, maintenance, mobilization planning, sustainment planning, and item management classification.

# CM Definitions

- After much debate, JIWG voting members (Army, Navy, USAF, USMC, DLA, USTRANSCOM, and Joint Staff/J4) voted 7-0 to adopt definition number 3
- This definition will be submitted to DAUD (Transportation Policy) for inclusion in the final coordination draft of DOD Instruction 4500.57, Transportation and Traffic Management.
- DODI 4500.57 to be released on or about 1 August 2011

# JIWG Approved Container Management Definition

- Container Management: Planning, organizing, directing, controlling, and executing of all functions and responsibilities required to provide for positive and effective use of DOD/Service-owned, leased or controlled ISO containers. Includes, but is not limited to, the functions and responsibilities of life cycle asset and operational management supporting the full spectrum of operations.
