# Container Management Board

- Discussion:
  - Define SDDC's authorities, roles, and responsibilities for DoD Container Management
  - Develop and implement a Container Management Board (CMB) subordinate to the Joint Intermodal Working Group (JIWG) concept plan
  - Coordinate with all Services and Agencies to integrate the concept and requirements
  - The Container Management Board provides decisions for enterprise wide container management
- Way Ahead:
  - Finalize a Memorandum of Understanding with the services and TRANSCOM
  - JIWG to concur on a CMB



# Container Management Training Programs

- Discussion:
  - Define and implement Container Management training curriculum
  - Coordinate with FORSCOM and 1st Army for Container Management training execution
  - Coordinate Container Management training with JFCOM, Services and Agencies for implementation into their curriculum
- Way Ahead:
  - Finalize Container Mgt Training Curriculum Jun 1
  - Web Base Training Jul 1



# Strategy to Reduce Container Costs for Detention and Leasing

- Discussion:

- Coordinate with Key Stake holders on Container Mgt LOI rewrite
- Review and update current Strategies and Business Practices
- Continue to provide IBS CMM training to deploying units

- Way Ahead:

- Improve planning and communication with key stake holders on container strategy
- Provide guidance on current and future business practices in dealing with carrier owned containers, policies and alternative options to migrate detention



# JIPMS Enhancement

- Discussion:
  - Coordinate web-service interfaces with systems for sharing of data to improve data quality
  - Develop JIPMS strategy for best way ahead to next level
- Way Ahead:
  - Continue to enhance data sharing
  - Review JIPMS Phase 1 & 2 Spirals
